

What is SB 367?

Senate Bill 367, or Juvenile Justice System Reform, is a Kansas state law passed in 2016. But what exactly does it do?

\$ EVERY DOLLAR
REINVESTED

By law, every single dollar that would have been spent on incarceration will be reinvested in effective programs and local alternatives, like community rehabilitation centers, that prevent more youth crime and recidivism.

\$72 MILLION DOLLARS

Almost \$72 million will be available for community programs to keep kids out of jail and in their homes and communities.



60%

SB 367 will reduce the number of incarcerated Kansas kids by 60% over the next five years without compromising public safety.
